The Rocklands White Hart pub has closed and, unless reopened within the next few months, an application for change of use may be granted which might mean there will never be a pub in the village again. Whether you live in Rocklands or any of the nearby communities, we hope you share our concern to prevent this happening.

**What can we do?** There is a lot of enthusiasm for the pub to reopen. We intend to attract enough shareholders from the region to capitalise a company to buy The White Hart and operate it commercially. This company would belong to a large number of individuals – people like us and, we hope, people like you.

We intend to offer shares with a minimum holding of £250 person. A single share may be bought over a period of a year at the rate of £5 per week so that as many people as possible are able to participate in the pub.

If you are seriously interested in keeping The White Hart as a pub, please sign a pledge indicating the amount of shares you might consider purchasing. A pledge is not legally binding but it does give us an idea of how much money we might expect to raise. **So, what's the plan?** Our vision is for a commercially successful, completely independent pub, with no borrowings and no brewery tie, owned by local shareholders, with a community association cradled within it. We expect the pub to stand on its own feet, competing fair and square with other village locals. The community association will have a mutually beneficial relationship with the pub, using space and providing volunteer-run services to complement the commercial operation.

**What will you get out of it?** A share in a truly independent Free House. A great place to meet, eat, share a drink and celebrate. A real opportunity to have your say and influence how the pub is managed. The satisfaction of knowing that you have contributed towards making it happen and you should even receive a dividend.
